How you can help:

Conserve Energy: Reduce energy by switching off lights and closing windows if heating is on. There is a pulley in the utility room for drying laundry. For more information go to www.energysavingstrust.org.uk

Reduce, Re-use, Recycle: Avoid overly packaged goods, say no to disposable carrier bags, Please recycle while you are here: glass, aluminium cans, plastic bottles, newspaper, cardboard, batteries. The recycling bins are adjacent to the car park.

Be Water Wise: Turn off the tap when brushing your teeth, only boil what you need, drink tap water instead of bottled, only use washing machines for full loads.

Respect Nature: Help us look after this special place by not littering, guarding against fire, using footpaths and cycle-ways responsibly.

Give the Car a Rest: There are lots of lovely walkways and cycle paths in the area. There are bus timetables and details of public transport in the **'General Information'** folder in your cottage.

Shop Locally: Lundin Links, Lower Largo, Leven and the East Neuk villages have a selection of small independent retailers.
